Based on our most recent survey, we found that our partners use Fit Kids in multiple ways including:

Our partners indicated that students love to use Fit Kids resources at home for physical activity and to manage stress and anxiety including:


- The Fit Kids student app (free in the app store for Fit Kids participants)



What Was New in '22?

Fit Kids made a number of significant advances during the past school year.

Fit Kids Founder Ashley Hunter was named to the Governor's Advisory Council on Physical Fitness and Mental Well-Being. "This Council's work is critical. Even before the pandemic, California and most other places already faced a health crisis in terms of childhood obesity and many other physical and mental ailments stemming from inactivity. With the pandemic on top of that, immediate action is needed. I am thrilled to serve on this council alongside such accomplished members and can't wait to see our positive impact on public health."

The Fit Kids Celebration & Concert, our first fundraising event since 2019, featured the musical duo Music Travel Love. More than 150 Fit Kids supporters at Sharon Heights Golf Club also heard from Fit Kids participant **Sebastian Ramos of Horace** Mann Elementary School in Oakland and Franky Navarro and Lamont Robinson, Jr. of the Oakland Athletic League.





Fit Kids established its first partnership in the Minneapolis-St. Paul area, incorporating our program into **Perspectives** a non-profit that addresses the community's issues around homelessness, racial disparity, poverty, trauma, mental and chemical health issues, and nutrition.

Long-time Board of Directors member Wendy McAdam took over as chairperson. "All kids should have fitness in their lives. Lack of fitness is such a big problem, but also one that should be solvable."







Financial Performance in Fiscal Year 2022
